## Religious Education & Exploration

The R.E. program at UUCLR is a place for seekers of all ages to dig deeper and become our best selves. Here, we discern individual morals, ethics, and beliefs. We look for meaning in all of life, even the most mundane. Here, we work together to build beloved community, looking to our shared U.U. Seven Principles to help guide us in our engagement with each other and the world. Our Six Sources offer a framework for this lifelong process of learning, exploration, and faith development. We offer age-appropriate classes and small groups, as well as multigenerational opportunities. This 2016/2017 church year, all ages will explore UUCLR's monthly church-wide themes using a variety of stories, workshops, spiritual practices, discussion, and the sharing of lived experience.

### Unitarian Universalist Seven Principles

- 1<sup>st</sup> Principle: The inherent worth and dignity of every person;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Principle: Justice, equity and compassion in human relations;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Principle: Acceptance of one another and encouragement to spiritual growth in our congregations;
- 4<sup>th</sup> Principle: A free and responsible search for truth and meaning;
- 5<sup>th</sup> Principle: The right of conscience and the use of the democratic process within our congregations and in society at large;
- 6<sup>th</sup> Principle: The goal of world community with peace, liberty, and justice for all;
- 7<sup>th</sup> Principle: Respect for the interdependent web of all existence of which we are a part.

### Our Principles In Children's Language:

2. We believe that all people should be treated fairly and kindly.
3. We believe that we should accept one another and keep on learning together.
4. We believe that each person must be free to search for what is true and right in life.
